

### **About This Presentation**

Have you or a loved one had hernia mesh implanted specifically for hernia repair, had serious complications (infections, wound reopening, chronic pain, bowel obstructions), or had revision or repair surgery? You may be a victim of a product that was defectively designed.

You may be entitled to compensation.



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- Particularly serious instances of perforation and infection have resulted in blood poisoning and death
- Once implanted into a person's body, remedial surgeries are risky and some victims never fully recover from the damage caused even if removed

### **Types of Hernia Mesh Products**

Hernia mesh products can be made from biological or synthetic materials.

#### **Biological Hernia Mesh**

- Derived from animal tissue (usually cow or pig skin or intestine) that is disinfected before it is implanted
- Fully absorbable, this mesh eventually degrades in the body and is expected to be replaced by new human tissue growth to strengthen the area bridged or patched

### **Types of Hernia Mesh Products**

#### **Synthetic Hernia Mesh**

- Can be made from both absorbable and/or non-absorbable materials
- Non-absorbable mesh products, including those made from polypropylene plastics, are considered permanent

Some types of hernia mesh products, particularly types of synthetic mesh, have been subject to recalls or are currently under review by government health agencies and regulators.

they can be held liable for damages and face punitive judgments if the courts
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
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#### Mesh Lawsuit in Canada

- When companies manufacture and/or market a defective product to Canadians they can be held liable for damages and face punitive judgments if the courts find their negligence contributed to these damages.
- Victims of defective hernia mesh interested in pursuing legal remedies should consult with a lawyer who is knowledgeable about personal injury law and product liability.
- Judgments in favor of these plaintiffs or negotiated settlements with companies found liable, can provide these victims with financial awards to compensate them for their injuries, disabilities, or future medical needs (such as remedial surgeries).

A victim must sometimes meet a particular threshold or condition to join a defective hernia mesh mass tort lawsuit.



#### The following situations are general indications that you may qualify:

- 1. You have experienced complications that you believe are the result of the defective mesh implant. These commonly include:
  - chronic pain (more than three months)
  - infection or abscess
  - hernia recurrence
  - mesh migration or adhesion

- obstruction
- fistula formation
- organ perforation



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- 2. The mesh that was implanted to repair a hernia or hernias is found on the recall list.
- 3. You have had or require revision surgery to treat recurrence or infection from hernia mesh.
- 4. You require surgery to remove the hernia mesh product.

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- recognize that a "one-size-fits-all" approach doesn't always work best for everyone involved, and
- are generally funded through contingency fees which help to facilitate participation by people who may not be able to pay for legal services up front.



## Other Faulty or Defective Medical Devices and Implants

Hernia mesh is one of many faulty or defective medical devices and implants reported to have caused suffering, disability and death to users.





## Other Faulty or Defective Medical Devices and Implants

Two faulty or defective medical devices and implants that have been subject to manufacturing recalls or warnings from health agencies and regulators include:

- St. Jude Defibrillator/Pacemaker
- SynchroMed II.
